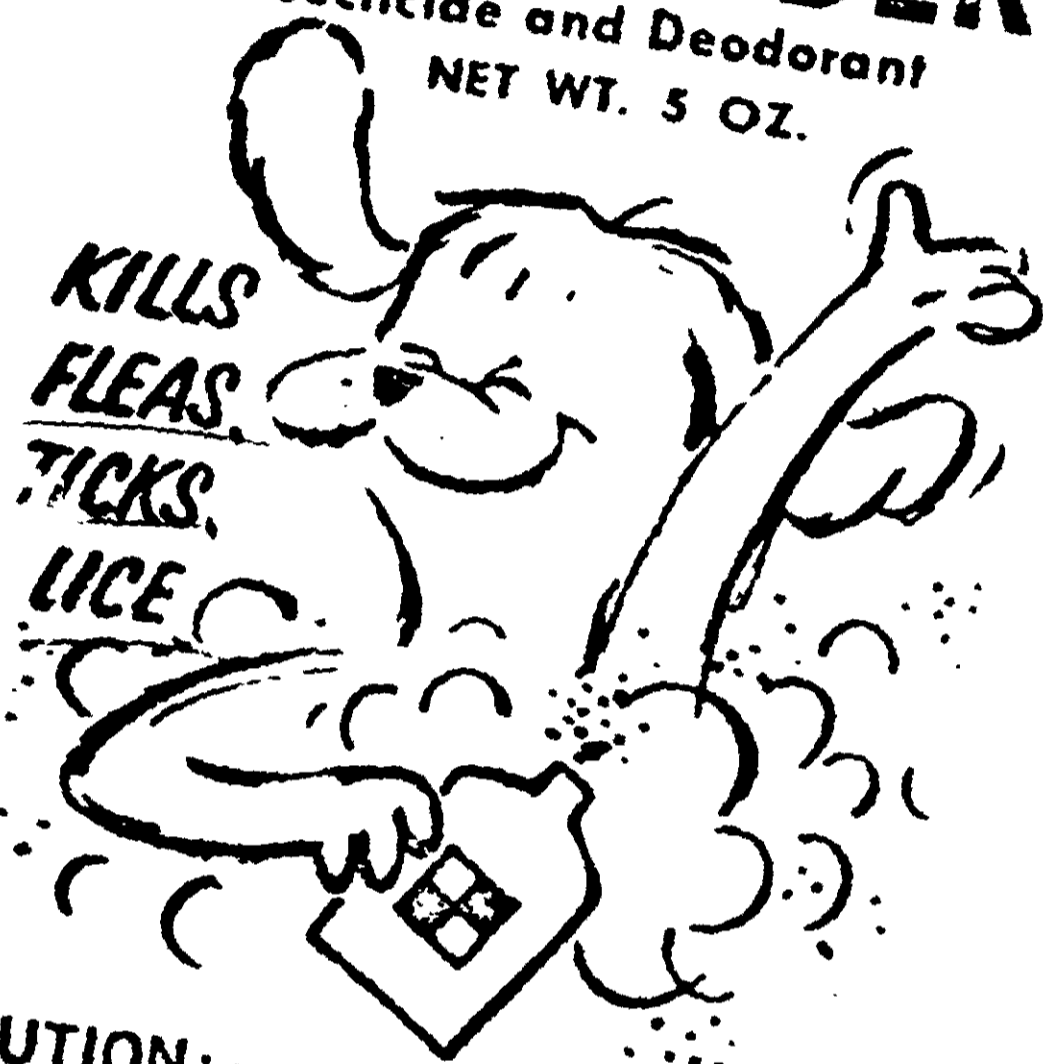


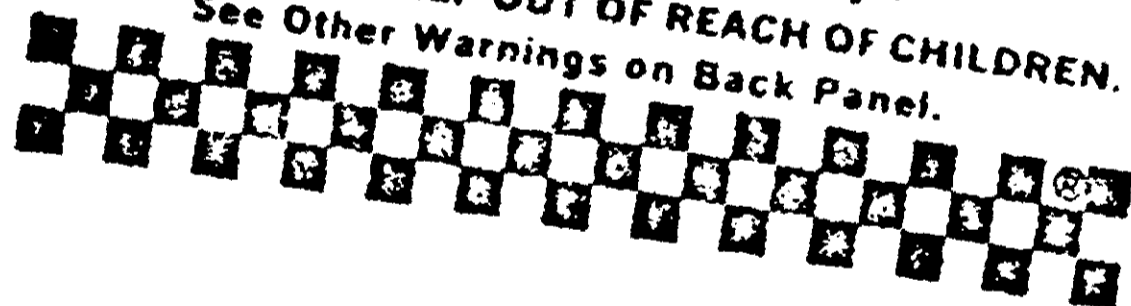

## DIRECTIONS

Shake well before using. Lift nozzle and squeeze container to dust. Puff powder well into dog's coat. rub in thoroughly down to skin, avoiding the eyes. Repeat as necessary but not more often than weekly. Dog's bedding and sleeping quarters should also be dusted to help prevent reinfestation.

**Ticks:** Ticks may attach firmly to skin, including inner ear surface. Dust dog thoroughly, including inner ear region if necessary. Ticks may not drop off after treatment even though dead. Brush off dead ticks after 24 hours.

Purina Dog Powder aids in controlling itching caused by insects, certain bacteria and fungi. It also aids in controlling doggy odors.

**CATS:** May be used on cats over 4 weeks of age.

**CAUTION:** As with any effective insecticide, care should be taken to avoid breathing dust. Wash hands after using. Keep out of reach of children.
