"Deadly" Brand Rodent Destroyers will kill many small animals if the gases can reach them, in a confined place such as a burrow. For gophers and moles it is usually best to find the main runway. Sometimes a burrow is "active", is open and the animal seen. Treat these quietly and with as little disturbance as possible. In many cases the lateral running to the mound of dirt may be open for a short distance, then plugged; the gases will back up. By further probing, runway may be relocated and an effective gassing made. To find main runway select freshest dirt mound; dig in direction of hole until it connects with main runway, usually a foot or so from the mound. Uncover enough of the runway so that the Destroyers can be used in both openings. Try Destroyer in the holes. If dirt or sharp turns interfere, clean out until Destroyers go freely into hole. Have earth ready to plug hole; light fused end and quickly put it, burning end first, as far along one channel as you can; tamp behind it with earth at once. Insert another lighted Destroyer in opposite burrow and plug. Where there are many mounds of earth pushed up, smooth all these over; work from the new mounds later. Sometimes there is little evidence of mounds although there are rodents working. Runways may be located by a probing bar. If earth is not too hard, an iron bar 1/2" in dia. and 6" long may be thrust into the suspected place and runways located. If earth is hard, try a bar 2" long and hit it with a hammer. As bar goes through runway it can be "felt" as there is no resistance. Dig here to find burrow. For ground squirrels, skunks, prairie-dogs that leave open holes, simply use one or more Destroyers and have dirt ready to plug hole. If gas escapes from other openings, cover with earth. If look is some distance from where the Destroyer is used, it is advisable to use another at this point.

Do not use or store near heat, smokers, open flames or inflammable material, or use in a closed space like building, dry grass, etc. Keep unused Destroyers away from those being ignited. For extra fire and moisture protection, a container such as a coffee can is good to keep them in. Because they are inflammable, keep away from children. Do not breathe gas; when lighting do not point toward person. Wear leather gloves. Store in a dry place, if damp, dry out.
