HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

PHYSICAL & CHEMICAL HAZARDS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product is to be used only in the formulation EPA registered insecticides. Formulators are responsible for submitting label to EPA.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

STORAGE: If container is damaged. Stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL (cont.)

Contact with the product or its vapors. Cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand, or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent on to a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below. Do not store, use, pour, or spill near heat or open flame.
