**DIRECTIONS
ROSES**

Diseases: Powdery Mildew, Leaf Spot, Black Spot, Rust.

Mix one pound Prentox Sulfur in 10 gallons of water or apply dust from the can. NOTE: Used as a spray—Mix 8 teaspoonsful in a little water to make a thin paste add to 1 gallon water and agitate during application. One pound makes 10 gallons diluted spray.

Apply as a dust or can be diluted with water for a spray. For best results apply in early morning or late evening when the temperature is low and the air is still. Apply so all exposed parts are contacted, especially upper and lower leaf surfaces. Do not treat during periods of excessively high temperature (above 90° F.). Leaf damage to foliage may occur. Disease control on roses should be preventive so treat before damage appears and follow a regular program.

APPLES

Disease: Scab

PRE-BLOSSOM APPLICATIONS
Prentox Sulfur and 1/2 pounds of hydrated lime to 25 gallons of water, or 1/2 gallon of lime sulfur solution and 2 pounds of Prentox Sulfur to 50 gallons of water.

PETAL FALL OR CALYX APPLICATION
1/2 pounds of Prentox Sulfur and 1/2 pound of hydrated lime to 25 gallons of water.

SUMMER APPLICATION AFTER THE CALYX STATE—2 pounds of Prentox Sulfur and 1/2 pounds of hydrated lime to 50 gallons of water.

PEACHES, PLUMS and CHERRIES

Disease: Brown Rot and Peach Scab

2 pounds of Prentox Sulfur to 33 1/2 gallons of water are recommended for application before or soon after bloom for brown rot blossom blight control on stone fruits. 2 pounds of Prentox Sulfur to 50 gallons of water are recommended for use on peaches and brown rot near harvest peaches, plums, and cherries.

Sulfur may burn foliage when temperatures are excessively high.
