Dear Ms. Hickman:

The above mentioned amendment submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA is accepted provided that you adhere to the following comments.

1. Under the "Precautionary Statements" you must add the phrase; "Wear goggles, face shield or safety glasses, when handling.
2. Update your "Environmental Hazard" section to read; "For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not apply where run-off is likely or where weather conditions favor movement away from target areas. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash waters.
3. Your "Storage and Disposal" statement should follow the appropriate format (see enclosed). Under the "storage" section add; "Avoid contact with floor and moisture".
4. The "Disclaimer" statement should be listed as was in EPA Reg. No. 7001-337.

A stamped label is enclosed for your records.

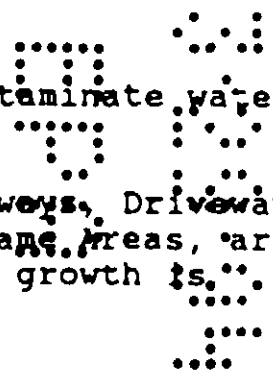
STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If In Eyes: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention. If On Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If Swallowed: Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg white and gelatin solution or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Get medical attention. Note To Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not apply directly to water ~~surroundings~~. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

For killing plant life and preventing re-growth in Roadways, Driveways, Paths, Patios, Fence Rows, Curb Lines, Parking Areas, Game Areas, around Foundations, Buildings and similar areas where no plant growth is wanted. Prevents plant growth for one or more years.



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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For household use only.

USE PRECAUTIONS: GRANULAR NOXALL is a non-selective weed killer and is toxic to most vegetation. Confine the treatment to the area where the plants are to be killed. Avoid contact with lawns, perennials and other desirable plants. Avoid treatment of soil over roots of desirable plants, such as trees, shrubs and vines. Avoid run-off from treated area to desirable plants and lawns.

PLEASE READ ENTIRE LABEL.

Use only as directed, noting all cautions.

Remove safety cap and push in sprinkler hole seals for first use. Replace safety cap for storage of unused portion.

1. MOIST SOIL - for best results, soil of treated area should be moist at time of application. Rainfall or artificial watering is required to carry the material into the soil before it becomes effective as a root killer.

2. ANNUAL GRASSES AND WEEDS -

a. For most effective control, this material should be applied just prior to emergence, or at time when weeds are in seedling stage of growth (1 to 2 inches high).

b. Apply at the rate of 2 pounds per 100 square feet (contents of this package will cover approximately 250 sq. ft.) for seasonal control of most annual weeds and grasses.

3. PERENNIAL GRASSES AND WEEDS AND FOR EXTENDED CONTROL -

a. Apply at the rate of 2 pounds per 50 square feet (contents of this package will cover approximately 125 sq. ft.).

b. Apply to damp soil, preferably at a time when there will be enough expected rainfall to adequately carry the material into the root zone.

4. Re-treat persistent or spot re-growth as necessary to maintain desired control.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store this product in its original container and keep in a locked storage area out of reach of children and domestic animals. Do not reuse container. Securely wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

Filled by weight not by volume. Product may settle after packaging.
