## **Directions for Dilution**

Dilute with water as directed.

For Roccal 1:625 (1600 ppm) approx., add and stir 2 oz. (4 tablespoons) of Roccal 10% in 1 sallon of water.

For Roccal 1:1250 (800 ppm) approx., add and stir 1 oz. (2 tablespoons) of Roccal 10% in 1 gallon of water.
