The labeling amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, As Amended (FIFRA), is acceptable, provided that you:

- 1. Submit one copy of your final printed label incorporating the following corrections before you release the product for shipment.
- a. On the side panel, revise the heading, "FOR USE IN" to read as follows: FOR USE OUTDOORS.
- b. In item three under the side panel directions for use, correct the first sentence to read as follows: Spray the outer surfaces of bins, taking care to wet thoroughly all areas where insects might breed.
- c. In the recommendations for using PhosFume to fumigate the infested grain bins, add the additional directions cited below.

The PhosFume product must be used in accordance with the registered PhosFume product label directions, limitations and precautions and only for the grains listed on the registered PhosFume product label.

d. Correct the second and third sentences in the section headed, WHEN AND WHERE TO USE FARM BIN SPRAY by deleting the phrases, "Before fumigating full bins _ _ after fumigant gases have dissipated." so that they read as cited below.

Spray FARM BIN SPRAY on exterior of bins, ten (10) feet out from bin walls after cutting and removing high grass or weeds. This will prevent migrating insects from entering bins and also prevent grain insects from escaping and returning.

- e. The terms, ACTIVE and INERT INGREDIENTS must appear on the finished label in the same type size and prominence.
 - f. In the storage instructions, make the following corrections:

add the statement that the product should not be stored at temperatures exceeding 77 degrees F and that local heating above this temperature should be avoided; and,

correct the current reference to 80 degrees F to read: 50 to 77 degrees F.

- 2. Submit your corrected, updated Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) revised as described below within 90 days of the date of this letter. The revised updated CSF dated March 24, 1999 is not acceptable for the reasons stated below.
- a. Your supplier for the first listed active ingredient needs to be clarified. The supplier name cited in column 11 of the CSF does not agree with the company number cited in item 12c of the CSF. In addition, the full EPA Registration Number, consisting of the company number and the product number must be cited for your supplier product.

You are reminded that your supplier product label must allow for the formulation of end-use products for the uses specified on your label. You are also reminded that the label declaration for the percentage of active ingredients present in your product must be consistent with the submitted CSF; i.e. the label declaration must reflect the nominal concentration of the active ingredient, not the percentage of the technical product.

- b. The certified limits (items 14 a and 14b.) and the percentage by weight (item 13 b.) must be completed for each of the listed ingredients.
- c. The revised CSF is inconsistent with the subject product label in regards to the inert solvent (s) present in the product. The label declares the presence of two inert solvents whereas only one inert solvent is reported on the revised CSF. Please explain this discrepancy.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended label constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

This will prevent migrating insects from entering bins and also prevent grain insects from escaping and returing after furnigant gases have dissipated
