APPLICATION: MICROBIOCIDE 30 is used to inhibit the growth of algae in recirculating commercial and industrial cooling water systems. Before treatment with MICROBIOCIDE 30 systems must be cleaned to remove algal growth and other deposits. Then the system should be treated with an initial slug addition of 13.3 to 20 fluid ounces of MICROBIOCIDE 30 per 1,000 gallons of water in the system. Repeat the initial dosage until control is evident. Subsequent slug additions of 10 to 20 fluid ounces of MICROBIOCIDE 30 per 1,000 gallons of water should be made very 1 to 5 days or as needed. The required frequency of treatment depends on the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the microbiological problem. Slug additions of MICROBIOCIDE 30 should be made to the sump of water cooling towers. EPA Est. 1020-NJ-1
