Dear Ms. Schlekau;

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. Revise the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals statements as follows:

“Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse, Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Causes moderate eye irritation. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco.

Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, food storage or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed contamination of food or feed.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before use.”

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

NOTE: When used in hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

IN MISTING EQUIPMENT: Use in a cold aerosol generator or mechanical hand sprayer that produces particles of aerosol size (30 microns or less).

To Kill Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes and Small Flying Moths: Close room, warehouse or other area to be treated and shut off all ventilating systems. Dispense this product as a fine mist. Use a dosage of 1/2 ounce per 1,000 cubic feet of room space. Do not remain in treated areas. Leave room closed for 1/2 hour. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

IN PRESSURIZED TANK SPRAYERS FOR WETTING CONTACT SPRAYS: To kill the listed insects, the diluted spray should be used as follows at a rate of 1 gallon per 1,000 square feet of surface area.

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry.

To Kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these pests are seen or suspected.

To Kill Exposed Forms Of Confused Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils, And Saw-Toothed Grain Beetles: Find and destroy infested package foods. Remove other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Apply as a coarse wet spray to all other areas infested with these insects. Pay particular attention to cracks and crevices in floors, walls, and ceiling.

To Kill Firebrats and Sowbugs: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators and machinery.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other approved State and Local procedures.
