The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Pyriproxyfen Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted" is enclosed. Products shipped after 12 months from the date of this amendment must bear the new revised label. Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended label constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6.

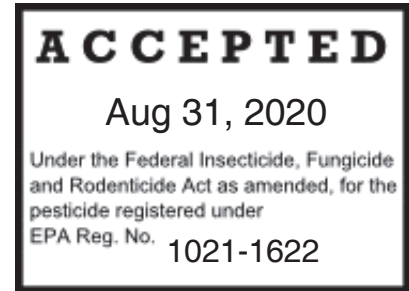

PESTICIDE RESISTANCE MANAGEMENT

Nylar Pressurized Spray 2618 contains a Group 7 insecticide. Any insect population may contain individuals naturally resistant to Nylar Pressurized Spray 2618 and other Group 7 insecticides. The resistant individuals may dominate the insect population if this group of insecticides are used repeatedly in the same fields. Appropriate resistance management strategies should be followed.

To delay insecticide resistance consider:

- Avoiding the consecutive use of Nylar Pressurized Spray 2618 or other Group 7 insecticides that have a similar target site of action, on the same insect species.
- Basing insecticide use on a comprehensive IPM program.
- Monitoring treated insect population for loss of field efficacy.
- Contacting your local extension specialist, certified crop advisors, and/or manufacturer for insecticide resistance management and or IPM recommendations for the specific site and resistance pest problem

Flea Spray [Brand Name] kills fleas and ticks. It contains a unique combination of ingredients that kills adult, preadult fleas [larva] and flea eggs. Even kills fleas before they grow up to bite. NYLAR, a unique ingredient in this flea spray, continues to kill fleas for 210 days [7 months] by preventing their development into the adult biting stage. It reaches fleas hidden in carpets, rugs, drapes, upholstery, pet bedding, and floor cracks. Protects your home from reinfestation and flea buildup and your pets and family from bites. One treatment with this spray gives continuous flea protection for 210 days. Leaves no objectionable odor or sticky mess and, used as directed, does not stain furnishings.

FLEAS & TICKS: SHAKE WELL. Hold can upright 2 or 3 feet from surfaces to be treated. [Turn container upside down and point valve toward surface to be sprayed]. Be sure to apply uniformly using a sweeping motion to carpets, rugs, drapes and all surfaces of upholstered furniture. Be sure to treat pet bedding, as this is a primary hiding place for fleas. No need to remove pet bedding after treatment. **DO NOT TREAT PETS.** Use a registered flea control product on your pets in conjunction with this treatment. Avoid wetting furniture and carpeting. A fine mist or spray applied uniformly is all that is necessary to kill fleas and ticks. Do not apply more than 1 time per week to the same surface for killing ticks.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE

Store in a cool, dry area. Always store pesticides in the original container. Store away from food and pet food.
