WHERE TO USE

For cleaning and disinfecting floors, walls, woodwork, metal door frames, filing cabinets and desks in sick rooms, operating rooms, shower and locker rooms, and similar areas where soil, bacteria and fungi contamination are high, in hospitals, hotels, motels and schools. Recommended for use on conductive floors. Harmless to resilient flooring tile, terrazzo, painted and varnished surfaces when used as directed. Remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits from surfaces prior to application of the recommended solution. Treated food contact surfaces must be scrubbed with detergent and rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

GENERAL CLEANING:

For all general cleaning and disinfecting including Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis, Pseudomonas aeruginosa, Mycobacterium tuberculosis, Trichophyton interdigitale, use one ounce to a gallon of water (1:128). Wet surfaces thoroughly with the recommended use dilution by wiping, mopping or scrubbing. Phenomysan-2 is functional at 1:128 dilution in water hardness up to 1,000 ppm.

MOLD & MILDEW: Destroys mold and mildew, on contact only, 1:128 dilution, using general cleaning directions.

DANGER

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
