Olin HTH<sup>®</sup> pool algaecide is an exceptional algaecide for all swimming pool water. When used as directed, it will control algae and offensive odors from pool water.

The pH of pool water should be maintained between 7.2 - 7.6. Check pH daily with Pool Test Kit.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

For initial treatment of clean pools, add 10 fluid ounces of Olin HTH<sup>®</sup> pool algaecide for each 1,000 gallons of water directly into the pool water.

Subsequently, add 4 fluid ounces of Olin HTH<sup>®</sup> pool algaecide for each 1,000 gallons twice a week.

If algae has already established a foothold, add initial treatment. If algae persists, repeat initial treatment. Loosen the dead algae from pool wall surface with brush and vacuum out of pool.

**DANGER:**

Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

**FIRST AID:**

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:**

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
