## **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**LAUNDRY** For white or color-fast fabrics, including nylon, dacron, orlon, linen or cotton. Use  $\frac{1}{2}$  to 1 cup Bleach per machine load or 1 tablespoon per gallon. Mix well, before adding laundry, if possible, either in pre-soak, wash water or first rinse. Rinse well. If adding direct to laundry, first dilute in quart of water.

**TO WHITEN** For yellowed or gray fabrics, such as nylon, dacron or orlon, use 2 tablespoons Bleach per gallon warm water. Wash fabric, then soak 15 to 20 minutes and rinse. Repeat if necessary. Use of Bleach in regular laundry will keep these fabrics white.

**STAINS** To remove light scorch or mildew, or stains of fruit, wine, tea, coffee, grass, vegetable or blood. Use 2 tablespoons Bleach per quart of cold water. Immerse 15 minutes. Rinse thoroughly. Repeat if necessary.

**DIAPERS** To deodorize, disinfect, and remove light stains. Use 1 tablespoon Bleach per gallon of water. Flush out soiled diapers, then immerse in solution in diaper pail. To wash, follow laundry directions.

**TOILET BOWLS** Cleanse bowl, flush. Add  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup Bleach, let stand 1 hour or overnight. Flush. Do not use toilet bowl cleaners along with Bleach.

**GENERAL HOUSEHOLD** As disinfectant, deodorizer or stain remover in kitchen, bath or sick-room. For refrigerator, sink, tile, dish cloth, garbage pail, wooden tools, tub or shower. Use 3 tablespoons Bleach per quart warm water. Wash, immerse or keep wet 5 minutes with Bleach solution. Rinse.

**COFFEE POTS, TEA POTS, GLASSWARE** Add 1 tablespoon Bleach to container or pan of water.
