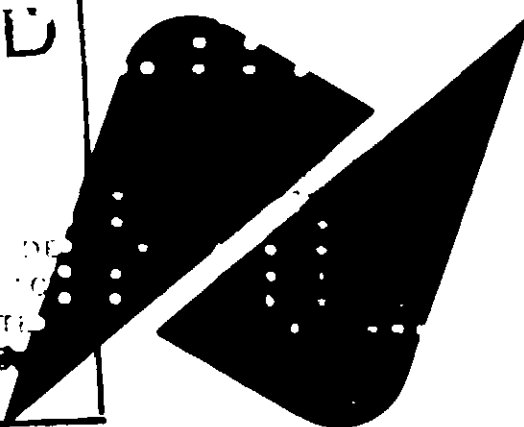

DIRECTIONS: Nalco H-170 Herbicide is used without dilution for non-selective control of herbaceous and woody plants on non-tillable lands such as railway rights-of-way and around tank farms, lumber storage, or similar places where vegetation is undesirable. Nalco H-170 is best applied at a rate of one gallon per thousand square feet after the predominant species have emerged. Suitable spray equipment should be used to obtain thorough wetting of all parts of the plant. Only moderate pressure is needed to give thorough coverage without atomization. Frequency of application depends upon type of growth and degree of control desired.

NOTE: Users should consult State Agricultural Experimental Stations or Extension Service Weed Specialists for recommendations as to use of Nalco H-170 in their particular area, or write to Nalco.

IMPORTANT: Do not apply Nalco H-170 directly to, or otherwise permit it to come in contact with, desirable plants. Do not apply to areas underlaid by roots of desirable trees and shrubs. Avoid spray drift to susceptible plants as this product may injure vegetables, flowers, grapes, fruit trees, ornamentals, cotton, or other plants sensitive to 2,4-D and its formulations. (Coarse sprays are less likely to drift.) Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not apply where run off is likely to occur. Thoroughly clean spray equipment with a suitable cleaner before using for other purposes (or do not use the same spray equipment for other purposes). Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides, or fungicides. Vapors from this product may injure susceptible plants in immediate vicinity. Do not contaminate irrigation ditches or water used for domestic purposes. Avoid excessive use in neighborhood of desirable animals, birds, and fish. Do not re-use shipping container for other materials without thorough cleaning. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

NALCO H-170 is toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not contaminate any body of water.

CAUTION: HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED. MAY CAUSE IRRITATION TO SKIN AND EYES. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and clothing. Do not inhale spray drift. Wash thoroughly after handling.
