DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Tobacco Insects. Hand Dusting Application for Budworms and To'acco Flea Beetles, when hand dust applications are made on individual plants, apply 6 to 8 pounds per acre. Heavier applications may cause plant injury. Rotary dusters are recommended. Broadcast Application for Hornworms, Budworms, Aphids, Flea Beetles, Suckfly, Grasshoppers and Japanese Beetles. Apply 20 to 40 pounds per acre depending on size of the plants. Use the highest rate only on large plants. Full coverage is essential. Begin treatment when worms are small and repeat as needed. Heavier applications may cause plant injury.

NOTE: If late applications are necessary, treat immediately after priming. Do not apply within 5 days of priming or 15 days of cutting. Avoid getting wet with plant juices when cutting the crop.

Some phytotoxicity may occur on tender foliage in the presence of rain or high humidity of several days duration following application.
