INSTRUCTIONS

1. Apply to moist grass near Memorial Day, July 4th, & Labor Day. Weeds are easiest to kill when in active growth and the temperature is 70° or higher. Lawn should be mowed a day or two prior to application.
2. Do not spread on new lawns until after two mowings. Do not apply on Dichondra, Ivy or similar broadleaf ground covers. Bent grass and clover may show temporary damage but will recover.
3. Rain within 24 hours will wash off the weed killer and require a second application. Also unusually resistant weeds may require a second application a week or two later.

**CAUTION:** Do not contaminate waters used for domestic or irrigational purposes. Store away from seeds, fungicides, insecticides and other fertilizers. In application, avoid drift onto desirable plants, shrubs and flowers. Clean spreader thoroughly after application and avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Excessive applications are wasteful and could be harmful.
