

ARTHITROL PASTE is a slow-drying insecticidal bait which is intended for the control of roaches, ants, and crickets.

INDOOR

Indoor application sites are areas such as: entry areas, lavatories, locker rooms, restrooms, machine areas, boiler rooms, garages, closets, storage areas, and commercial and private food storage, preparation, and consumption areas, such as pantries, kitchens, dining rooms, and taverns/bars.

Keep exposed paste away from open food and food contact surfaces. Do not treat food preparation surfaces, or locations where routine operations, such as cleaning, may transfer diluted bait to food or to food preparation surfaces. In case of accidental exposure to food preparation surfaces, clean the surface with a detergent.

The recommended application rate for small cockroaches such as German or Brown banded is 1 to 2 pea-sized spots (each about 0.25 gm) of bait per 6 square feet. This rate should be doubled for large cockroaches such as the American cockroach. In heavy infestations, the rate should be increased to 3 to 12 inch beads of bait per 6 square feet. Bait must not be placed where it is accessible to animals or children.

Arthitrol Paste is packaged in a plastic syringe dispenser. For applications in cracks and crevices, apply by touching tip to surface to be treated, then depress plunger to dispense desired amount of product. Recap dispenser when application is complete.

Inspect intended application sites to determine locations frequented by pest(s). (Monitoring of the infestation using the Zoecon monitoring trap may be helpful.) Place bait where inspection indicates the pests frequent. Usual locations includespots, cracks, and crevices under and behind files, storage cabinets, and equipment; under refrigerators and sinks; in, under, and behind cabinets and tables; in closets; in void spaces; in attics; in electrical boxes (use caution when applying to electrical boxes); in pantries and food storage areas; and under water heaters. Numerous small placements of bait will provide better control than fewer larger placements. This is especially true for German cockroaches. In cases where heavy activity is indicated in void spaces that cannot be reached with Arthitrol Paste, Arthitrol Granular Bait may be used in the spaces that cannot be effectively reached with the paste.

Use caution when applying paste to porous surfaces such as wallpaper, wood, or paper, as possible staining may result. In questionable cases, place a small amount of bait in an inconspicuous location. Application of bait in areas of high temperature, such as near stoves and fryers, may cause bait to run.

Foraging trails are effective baiting sites for ants. When baiting for ants, apply around trails and foraging areas. Foraging workers will transport the product into the colony and down to the brood and queen(s). Colony kill times may vary from a few days to six weeks. Retreatment is desirable for large mounds and in the event of rains.

OUTDOOR

For outdoor baiting, use recommended indoor rates and place in areas adjacent to the structure, at potential access points such as foundation cracks, soffits, sills, pipe and wire penetrations, expansion joints and eaves, in/around wood piles, around windows, doors, sashes, storage buildings, siding, shingles, eaves, weep holes, and water meter boxes. Concentrate applications at point of entry areas.

For heavy infestations, a reinspection of the treated area is recommended between one week and one month after initial bait placement. Replace bait as necessary if visibly depleted and the pest(s) are still present. You should notice visible reduction in the pest(s) within a few days after application.
