ANTIDOTE - Give a tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Then give 2 tablespoonsful of Epsom Salt or Milk of Magnesia in water and plenty of milk or water. Call a physician immediately.

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams and ponds. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of water.

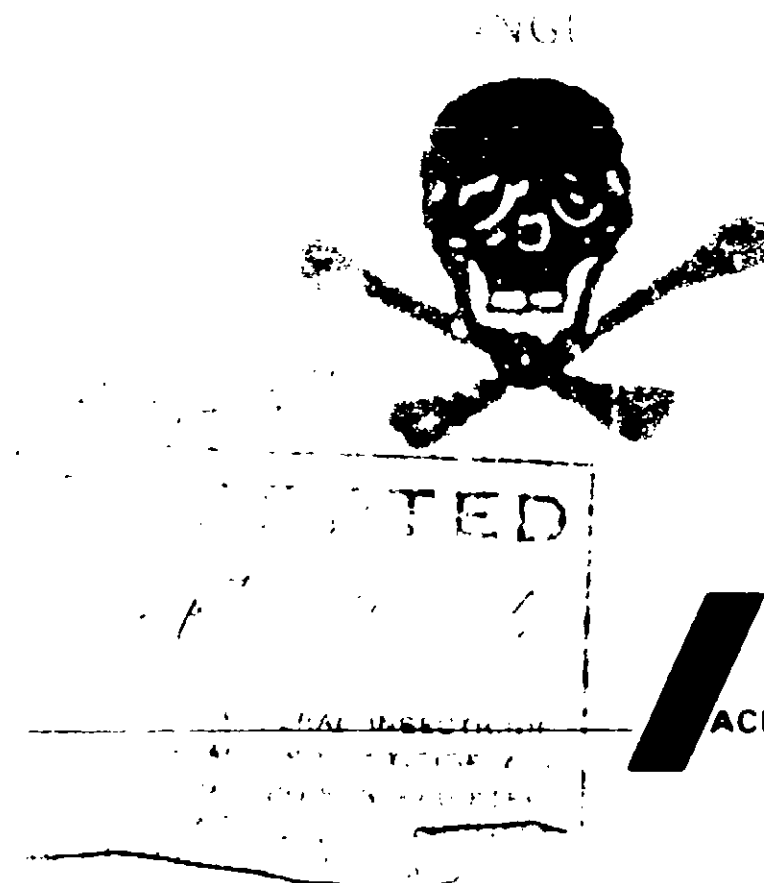
Do not reuse empty container. Destroy empty container by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

CADET is a liquid Cadmium solution which mixes with water quickly and thoroughly.

For prevention and control of Copper Spot and Dollar Spot, use 1 fluid ounce of CADET in 5 gallons of water per 1000 square feet of turf. Repeat every 10 days throughout turf disease season.

Do not graze treated areas. Do not feed clippings to livestock.
