DANGER

Extremely hazardous if swallowed. Causes severe burns to skin and eyes. Causes damage to mucous membranes.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Harmful to aquatic life. Harmful to fish. Harmful to other aquatic organisms. Harmful to the environment.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS
STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT

Very reactive with many materials. Reacts violently with acids. Reacts with organic materials.

SWIMMING POOLS

For pools containing swimming equipment, add one-half pound of chlorine per 1000 gallons of water. Add by slow solution. The chlorine may be determined differently when the pool is in use. Add a chlorine test kit. If additional chlorine is needed, add hypochlorite solution as follows:

GALLONS OF WATER

SODIUM HYPOCHLORITE SOLUTION REQUIRED

500	4 teaspoon
1000	8 teaspoon
5,000	7/8 cup
10,000	1 2/3 cup
25,000	4 cups
50,000	11 1/2 cups
100,000	23 1/2 cups
110,000	26 oz.

To complete the treatment, add regular super chlorine bleach. For each 1000 gallons of hypochlorite, add 10 times the amount of bleach. Apply after leaving pool area. Stir the pool until the chlorine has completely dissolved. Dilute the regular chlorine bleach solution with at least 10 times its volume. The chlorine solution can then cover the entire surface of the pool from the edges to the center.

MEAT AND POULTRY PROCESSING PLANTS

For meat and poultry processing plants, add one-half pound of chlorine per 1000 gallons of water. Add by slow solution. The chlorine may be determined differently when the plant is in use. Add a chlorine test kit. If additional chlorine is needed, add hypochlorite solution as follows:
