

Test spray a small portion of these materials if watermarking may be of concern. Do not use as a space spray. Provide adequate ventilation during application. Do not apply to animals, humans or food crops. Do not use in quarters housing animals raised for food. Do not use on any mode of transportation used to transport feed or food items.

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of poisoning, call a physician immediately. Have patient lie down and keep quiet.

If swallowed vomiting should be induced. Administer water freely and induce vomiting by giving one dose (1/2 oz. or 15 ml.) of syrup of ipecac. If vomiting does not occur within 10 to 20 minutes, administer second dose. If syrup of ipecac is not available, induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention immediately. If on skin, wash skin immediately with soap and warm water. If irritation occurs, get medical attention. If eyes are contaminated, wash with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention. If inhaled, remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.

SYMPTOMS OF POISONING: A sense of "tightness" in the chest. Sweating. Contracted pupils. Stomach pains. Vomiting and diarrhea.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: ANTIDOTE - Administer atropine sulfate in therapeutic doses. Repeat as necessary to the point of tolerance.

Compound inhibits cholinesterase resulting in stimulation of the central nervous system, the parasympathetic nervous system and the somatic motor nerves. Do not give morphine. Watch for pulmonary edema which may develop in serious cases of poisoning even after 12 hours. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be placed in an oxygen tent and treated symptomatically.
