As Agent for N. Jonas & Company Inc. ("Jonas"), I am submitting a Notification under the provisions of PR Notice 1998-10 to advise the Agency of minor changes to the label for On Guard Maxi-Clor Chlorine Powder (EPA Reg. No. 3432-12).

The label changes are as follows:

- 1) Move the First Aid statements to the front panel per the Agency's recent internal policy changing the current guidelines set forth in the Label Review Manual at Chapter 7, Part III, Section F(3). Previously, the Agency did "permit reasonable variations in the placement of the First Aid statement as long as the reference statement, 'See First Aid (or Statement of Practical Treatment) on [identify appropriate panel]' appears on the front panel." However, since recent comments for EPA Reg. Nos. 3432-35, 3432-36cand 3432-56 have indicated that this former policy has changed, Jonas wants to ensure that all of their Toxicity Category I chlorinated products are in compliance with the new rule. 000000

An alternative method for start-up would be to add 11 ozs. of this product per 10,000 gallons of water as a shock dose to satisfy the chlorine demand of water. This dose should be repeated until a chlorine residual of 1-2 ppm is obtained. Then a dosage of 1.5-2.0 ozs. per 10,000 gallons of water (1 teaspoonful per 1,000 gallons) should be added daily or as needed to maintain a 1-2 ppm  $_{
