- c. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read:
- “Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Fatal is absorbed through skin. Harmful if swallowed. Harmful if inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing (dust, vapor or spray mist). Wear protective eyewear (goggles, face shield, or safety glasses). Wear protective clothing and gloves (specify protective clothing and type of gloves). Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.”
- d. Under the “Storage and Disposal” add the statement “Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.”

Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

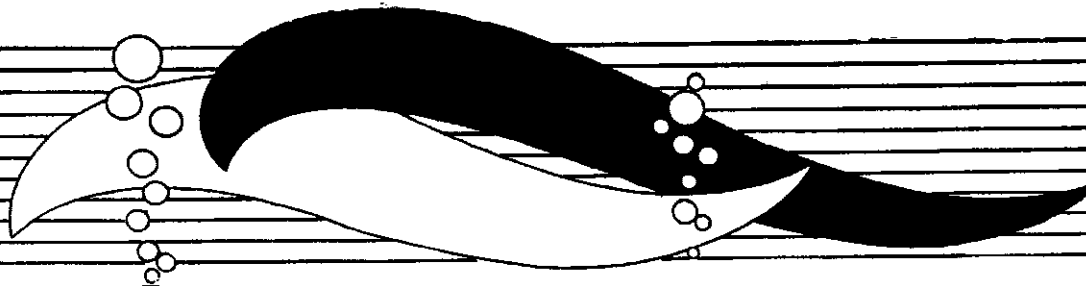

FIRST AID STATEMENT

IF SWALLOWED:	Call a poison control or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
IF IN EYES:	Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

ONE TABLET TREATS UP TO 8,000 GALLONS

Once-A-Week Tarry 2 oz. Metered Chlorinating Tablets provide effective control of bacteria and algae growth in pool water. DO NOT add this product directly to pool water or to continuous tablet chlorinating devices. Tarry 2 oz. Metered Chlorinating Tablets are intended for addition to the pool skimmer or into a floating dispenser. Do not mix this product with any other chemical.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Reentry into treated swimming pools/spas is prohibited above levels of 3.0 ppm.

START-UP: When starting up a reopened or freshly filled swimming pool, make sure that the filtration system is clean and operating properly. Then adjust and maintain the pH in the range of 7.2 to 7.6. Use Coastal pH Plus or pH Minus as indicated by a PoolChem Test Kit. Follow label directions for these products. Then superchlorinate with Blast One Shot Shock Treatment or Iso Chlor Super Stabilized Chlorinating Powder to establish a free chlorine residual of 1.0 to 1.5 ppm (parts per million). If your pool has not been stabilized previously, add Coastal Chlorine Stabilizer (cyanuric acid) until 30 ppm is obtained following label directions.

DAILY: Add Tarry 2 oz. Metered Chlorinating Tablets to the pool skimmer or floating dispenser as necessary to maintain a 1.0 to 1.5 ppm chlorine residual. A suggested dosage is one Tarry 2 oz. Metered Chlorinating Tablet (approx. 2 oz.) per 8,000 gallons of water daily. This dosage may vary due to unusual conditions such as heavy bather loads, wind, heavy rains and high temperatures. Therefore, frequent use of a PoolChem Test Kit is recommended as a guide to maintain the pH at 7.2 to 7.6 and the chlorine residual at 1.0 to 1.5 ppm.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Keep Out Of Reach Of Children. **CORROSIVE.** Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. May be fatal if absorbed through skin. May be fatal if inhaled. Do not breathe dust or spray mists. Irritating to nose and throat. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT. Mix only with water. Use clean, dry utensils. Do not add this product to any dispensing device containing remnants of any other product. Such use may cause a violent reaction leading to fire or explosion. Contamination with moisture, organic matter, or other chemicals may start a chemical reaction with generation of heat, liberation of hazardous gases, and possible generation of fire and explosion. In case of contamination or decomposition, do not reseal container. Isolate container, if possible, in open air or well ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water to dissolve all material before discarding container.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish and other aquatic organism. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge.
