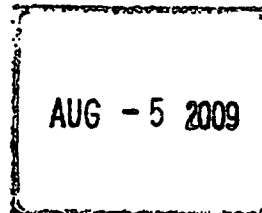

Per PR Notice 2007-4, The Procter & Gamble Company is submitting the following notification for the addition of container disposal language identical to that contained in 40 CFR 156.140. The statement identifying a nonrefillable container, reuse statement and recycling/reconditioning statement (proposed updates) will be added to the packaging once approved, along with the existing batch code.

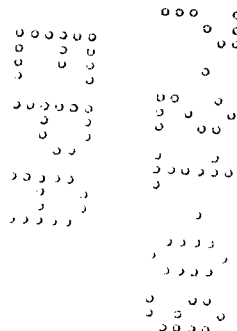
