**FLYING INSECTS**

**FLEAS, MOSQUITOES, GNATS:** Direct the spray toward the upper portion of the enclosure and fill the atmosphere with mist using 2 to 3 ounces of the product to each 1000 cubic feet of space. If possible, keep the doors and windows closed for 10 minutes after applying the spray.

**CRAWLING INSECTS**

(Exposed or accessible stages)

**ROACHES, SILVERFISH SPIDERS:** Spray infested areas thoroughly and direct the liquid behind baseboards, moldings, cabinet shelves, under doors and window frames and papers toward drains and dark corners, and into cracks, crevices, recesses and similar hiding places. Repeat as needed.

**ANTS:** Treat shelves, cabinet and storage areas. Spray entrance, track, baseboards, thresholds and other places of entry, and treat nests liberally.

**FLAAS, TICKS:** Direct the spray toward lower wall panels, baseboards, rugs, carpets and floors of infested areas. Spray animal quarters, kennels and the bedding of pets and other domestic animals.

**BIBBLES:** Apply liberally to top, end, sides and bottom of mattress, spraying of full, seams and folds. Spray springs and frame, directing the liquid into all cracks, crevices and back panel. Spray walls, baseboards, moldings, floors, steps and bed-room furniture with special attention to protected bedding, hiding and breeding places.

**CLOTHES MOTHS and CARPET BEETLES:** Remove infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly and if possible on one-half hour in direct sunlight. Apply spray liberally to all surfaces of empty chest, closet, bureau and storage, directing the liquid into cracks, joints and crevices. After airing infested articles may be treated by holding the spray nozzle at least 3 feet away from the fabric and applying the liquid lightly to avoid the possibility of staining. Treat both sides of rug, carpets and pads and all exposed and accessible surfaces of over-stuffed furniture. Repeat application in 30 days for susceptible articles not stored in moisture containers.

**STORED FOOD PESTS:** If exposed stages of flour beetles, weevils, cabinet grain beetles, meal worms, meal moths, shippers, grain and chaff beetles, to avoid sources of reinfestation, empty flour, grain and cereals should be destroyed before treatment. Spray thoroughly all surfaces of shelves, bins, cupboards, cabinet pantries, lockers and similar storages with special attention to cracks, niches, crevices and other hiding places.

**FLYING INSECTS**

**FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS** (Leave the spray toward the upper portion of the enclosure and fill the atmosphere with mist using 2 to 3 ounces of the product to each 1000 cubic feet of space. If possible keep the doors and windows closed for 10 minutes after applying the spray.

**CRAWLING INSECTS**

(Exposed or accessible stages)

**ROACHES, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS** Spray infested areas thoroughly and direct the liquid toward baseboards, moldings, cabinets, shelves, sinks, door and window frames and pipes toward drains and dark corners and into cracks, crevices, recesses and similar hiding places. Repeat as needed.

**ANTS** Treat shelves, cabinets and storage areas. Spray and run trails baseboard, thresholds and other places of entry and treat nests liberally.

**BEES, TICKS** Direct the spray toward lower wall panels, baseboard, rugs, carpets and floors of infested areas. Spray animal quarters, kennels and the bedding of pets and other domestic animals.

**BEDBUGS** Apply liberally to top, ends, sides and bottom of mattress spraying all tufts, seams and folds. Spray springs and frame directing the liquid into all cracks, crevices and tick ports. Spray walls, baseboard, moldings, floor, closet and bedroom furniture with special attention to protected bedding, tubing and breeding places.

**CLOTHES MOTHS and CARPET BEETLES** Remove infested articles from storage. Brush thoroughly and, if possible, on several hours in direct sunlight. Apply spray liberally to all surfaces of empty chest, closets, bureaus and storage directing the liquid into cracks, joints and crevices. After spring infested articles may be treated by holding the spray nozzle at least 3 feet away from the fabric and applying the liquid lightly to avoid the possibility of staining. Treat both sides of rug, carpet and pad and all exposed and accessible surfaces of over-stuffed furniture. Repeat application in 30 days for susceptible articles not stored in airtight containers.

**STORED FOOD PESTS** (Exposed stages of flour beetles, weevils, rodents, grain borers, meal worms, mold mites, silverfish, gran and house flies). To avoid source of reinfestation, worms, flour, gran and cereals should be destroyed before treatment. Spray thoroughly all surfaces of shelves, bars, cupboards, cabinets, pantries, eatery and similar storages with special attention to cracks, holes, crevices and other hiding places.
