DIRECTIONS

Apply with a low pressure tank sprayer which gives a coarse wet spray for the control of ants, silverfish, waterbugs, spiders, roaches and crickets in supermarkets, restaurants, homes, institutions, food processing establishments, warehouses, furniture storage and libraries. Will not mix with water.
CAUTION: Do not spray near open flames, pilot lights, heating elements or other heating sources.

ROACHES, ANTS, SILVERFISH, WATERBUGS, SPIDERS, CRICKETS:
Spray directly on insects where possible. Also spray wet insect trails and surfaces where insects may breed or congregate, such as under sinks, drainboards, door sills, door frames, window frames, garbage cans and outdoor buildings. Re-treat as necessary.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, FLYING MOTHS AND WASPS:
Spray surfaces until wet where those insects alight or congregate, such as walls of porches, garages, house foundations, etc.

FLEAS AND ANTS OUTDOORS:
Spray to wet localized infestations of these insects. For ants, thoroughly wet hills and runways. Re-treat as necessary

CAUTION

Do not use in commercial food preparation areas or in edible products areas of food processing plants.
Do not allow children in treated areas until surfaces are dry.
Harmful if swallowed.
Keep away from heat and open flames
Keep container closed when not in use
Avoid prolonged or repeated skin contact.
Avoid prolonged or repeated inhalation of spray mist.
Avoid contamination of cooking utensils, food, feed and water supplies
Wash thoroughly after using, before eating or smoking with soap and water
Remove fish and birds from room during spraying

Note to Physician

Ronnel and Vapona are cholinesterase inhibitors. Atropine is an antidote. Treat symptomatically
