If swallowed—Call a physician immediately. DO NOT INDUCE vomiting without the advice of a physician. Vomiting may cause respiratory pneumonia. DIRECTIONS FOR USE (continued) REPEAT AS OFTEN AS NECESSARY FLYING INSECTS

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS: Direct the spray toward the upper portions of the enclosure and/or the underneath with mid, using 2 to 3 ounces of the product to each 1000 cubic feet of space. If in walls, keep the door and windows closed for 10 minutes after applying the spray.

CRAWLING INSECTS (Exposed or accessible stages)

ROACHES, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS: Spray infested areas thoroughly and direct the liquid toward baseboards, moldings, cabinets, shelves, sinks, doors and window frames and places toward drains and dark corners, and into cracks, crevices, recesses and similar hiding places. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: Treat shelves, cabinets and storage areas. Spray and non, trails, baseboards, thresholds and other places of entry, and treat nests liberally.

REAS, TICKS: Direct the spray toward lower wall portions, baseboards, rugs, carpets and Roofs of infested areas. Spray animal quarters, kennels and the bedding of pets and other domestic animals.

BIRDSESS: Apply liberally to top, ends, sides and bottom of mattresses, spraying all tufts, seams and folds. Spray springs and frame, directing the liquid into all cracks, crevices and bolt holes. Spray walls, baseboards, moldings. Rugs, carpets and bedroom furniture with special attention to protected bedding, hiding and breeding places.

CLOTHES MOTHS and CARPET BEETLES: Remove infected articles from storage, brush them thoroughly and, if possible, air several hours in direct sunlight. Apply spray liberally to all surfaces of empty chests, closets, bureaus and storage; directing the liquid into cracks, joints and crevices. After airing, infested articles may be treated by holding the spray nozzle at least 3 feet away from the fabric and applying the liquid lightly to avoid the possibility of staining. Turn both sides of rugs, carpets and pads and all exposed and accessible surfaces of over-stuffed furniture. Repeat application in 30 days for susceptible articles not stored in mothproof containers. For Carpet Beetles repeated liberal applications should be made to baseboards, corners and under-furniture where these insects tend to congregate and cause damage.

STORED FOOD PESTS (Exposed stages of flour beetles, weevils, codlings, grain beetles, meal worms, meal moths, skipping, grain and cheese mites): To avoid sources of infestation, remove food, grains and cereal should be destroyed before treatment. Spray thoroughly all surfaces of shelves, bins, cupboards, cabinets, pantries, larders and brother storage, with special attention to broths, dishes, glasses and other hiding places.
