



DIRECTIONS

- 1. To Operate: Hold can upright 18 to 24 inches from objects to be sprayed. Aim orifice towards insects in area.
- 2. Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats Flying Moths, Wasps: Close doors and windows. Direct spray upwards to all parts of the room, especially the upper corners and other areas where insects congregate. Allow 4 to 6 seconds per 1,000 cubic feet. Keep room closed for at least 15 minutes after treatment. Treated areas must be thoroughly ventilated before re-entry. Repeat as necessary for control.
- 3. Roaches, Silverfish, Ants, Spiders, Crickets, Fleas: Spray directly on insects where possible. Apply liberally into cracks and crevices of floors and walls, on floor coverings, under sinks, cabinets, refrigerators, in sleeping quarters of pets, and in other areas where insects breed and hide. Repeat as necessary for control.
- 4. Clothes Moths and Carpet Beetles: Clean clothing and carpets to be protected. Spray thoroughly, especially olds, seams, under collars and cuffs. Spray interior of trunks, closets, cupboards, and other storage areas. Treat top and underside surfaces of rugs and carpets. If not stored in mothtight containers, repeat treatment approximately every 30 days. Dry-clean clothing before re-use.

Warning
