DESCRIPTION

A highly concentrated, fast-acting insecticide in
form which quickly knock down and rapidly kill a
wide variety of both small flying and crawling in-
sects, flies, mosquitoes, roaches, and ants. This prod-
uct is especially recommended for use in areas where
human beings work or live such as industrial plants,
offices, hotels, and motels, apartment houses, hos-
pitals and transportation facilities. Not designed for
use in food processing plants.

DIRECTIONS

To spray, hold container upright and remove cap.
Point valve opening away from face and push button.

1. FLYING INSECTS: Flies, mosquitoes, gnats,
wasps and flying moths: Close all doors and win-
dows. Spray up into the air with sweeping motion,
keep about 3 feet from interior walls, fabrics, furni-
ture and plants. Keep room closed for about 15
minutes then remove dead insects. A 4 to 5 second
spraying will usually be sufficient for about 1000
square feet. It is unnecessary to completely fill the
room with mist. Repeat as necessary for control.

2. CRAWLING INSECTS: Roaches, waterbugs, sil-
verfish and crickets. Spray hiding places such as
baseboards and floor boards, moist places, open-
ings around sinks, drains and pipes, behind book-
cases and other storage areas, hitting as many in-
sects as possible. Repeat as necessary for control.

3. ANTS: Spray trails, hills, around window sills,
door frames and openings around pipes and base
boards where ants crawl. Repeat as necessary for
control.

4. CARPET BEETLES: Spray directly on these

insects, covering floors, baseboards, shelves and car-

pets. Repeat spraying at frequent intervals.

5. BLDBUGS: Spray baseboards, mouldings, floor
boards, and infested areas of carpet and rug.

Spray mattresses, particularly around seams and

tufts. Take beds apart and spray all joints. Repeat

as necessary for control.

6. SPIDERS, CENTIPEDES, SOW BUGS: Spray
webs and places where these pests inhabit. Repeat

as necessary for control.

7. FLEAS, TICKS: Spray floors, furniture coverings
and sleeping quarters of pets. Do not spray pets

directly. Repeat applications as necessary for con-

trol.

OXFORD DEO-SECT (AEROSOL)

PURPOSE

To control flying, crawling and crawling insects in the home, office, school, hospital, hotel, and other public places.

WHERE USED

Control of flying insects. Indoor use is recommended in homes, restaurants, grocery stores, office buildings, schools, hospitals, and transportation facilities.

PROPERTIES

Non-toxic. EPA Registered. Approved by the American Medical Association. Non-petroleum hydrocarbon. Other than EPA registered for insect control.

HOW USED

Turn spray bottle container upright and remove cap. Press spray nozzle firmly from face and push button.

1. FLYING INSECTS: Flies, mosquitoes, gnats, wasps and flying moths. Close all door and windows. Spray up and down with sweeping motion. Keep about 3 feet from interior walls, fabrics, furniture and plants. Keep room closed for about 15 minutes then remove dead insects. A 1 to 5 second spraying will usually be sufficient for about 1000 square feet. It is unnecessary to completely fill room with mist. Repeat as necessary for control.

2. CRAWLING INSECTS: Roaches, waterbugs, silverfish and crickets. Spray in corners, cracks, baseboards and floor boards, under tables, open cupboards, behind furniture and paper, behind books, and other objects that may harbor insects. Repeat as necessary.

3. ANTS: Spray along trails, around flower beds, shrubs, trees, and other outdoor structures. Repeat as necessary.

4. CARPET BEETLES: Spray directly onto carpet, baseboards, shrubs and carpets. Repeat as necessary.

5. BEDBUGS: Spray bases and surrounding areas. Spray the bottom of carpet and drapes, curtains, and other items that may harbor bed bugs. Repeat as necessary.

SPIDERS, CENTIPEDES, SOW BUGS: Spray directly onto the insects and other pests.

THE EFFECT

Effectiveness depends upon the type of insect and the amount of spray used.
