DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To Clean - use two (2) fluid ounces per gallon of water for cleaning toilet seats, lavatories, tub, other bathroom fixtures, kitchen cabinets and sinks.

To Clean Inside Toilet Bowls - add two (2) fluid ounces directly to the bowl water. Swab inside of bowl completely using a scrub brush or mop, making sure to get under the rim, then flush.

To Disinfect - after cleaning, use three (3) fluid ounces to one gallon of water on hard, inanimate, non-porous surfaces such as kitchen and bathroom floors, countertops, sinks, outside of toilets, bedpans, garbage and diaper pails. Apply with mop, sponge, or cloth. Wet surfaces thoroughly, let stand 10 minutes, then rinse.

To Disinfect Toilet Bowls - after cleaning, add three (3) fluid ounces directly to bowl water. Swab the bowl completely using a scrub brush or mop, making sure to get under the rim, let stand 10 minutes, then flush.

To Deodorize Restrooms and Bathrooms - use a few drops of 60% Pine Oil Disinfectant in toilet bowls and urinals.

To Deodorize and Sanitize Garbage Pails and other waste receptacles - wash using one (1) fluid ounce to one-quart of water.

Laundry: To boost cleaning power on heavily soiled fabrics such as greasy work clothes, add 1/2 cup to front loading washer or 1 cup to top loaders along with your regular laundry soap and detergent. Apply full strength to paint or stubborn grease spots and allow to soak until softened before washing.

Store out of reach of children. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
