The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the draft label is enclosed for your records. Submit five (5) copies of the finished printed label with the corrections listed below before the product is released for shipment under this new labeling.

1. Change the statement "Safe to use . . ." to read "May be used on" The word "safe" is not acceptable.
2. The statement, "Harmful if swallowed" should be moved together with the statement "Avoid contact with lips and eyes." Both statements should appear under the heading "Precautionary Statements, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals, Caution."
3. The statement "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling" must appear on the label after the heading, "Directions For Use."
4. Since this product contains a high degree of petroleum distillate a "Statement of Practical Treatment" must appear on the label such as:

If Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard. Call a physician immediately.
