

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS:

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid skin contact. May be absorbed through skin. In case of contact wash immediately with soap and water. Avoid inhalation of spray. Avoid contamination of food stuffs. Do not use on humans, pets, or plants. Remove bird cages and fish bowls from room before spraying. Keep out of reach of children.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

DIRECTIONS: Hold can about 2 feet away from clothing and spray so that aerosol particles lightly contact all surfaces, but not heavy enough to wet fabrics. In the case of clothing hung on racks, separate such clothing so that the spray mist will penetrate between the clothing and reach all exposed insects. In case of woollens, sweaters, blankets and similar items stored in drawers or on shelves, they should be removed and lightly sprayed if any infestation is present. Additional instructions may be had by spraying the inside surfaces of storage drawers, bins, cabinets or shelves.

Additional instructions may be had by spraying the inside surfaces of storage drawers, bins, cabinets or shelves.

Carpet beetles and clothes moth breed on the accumulations of woolen lint and dust which settles in cracks and other spots and which remains undisturbed for long periods of time. Such spots should be thoroughly sprayed to control any potential infestations and thus give better overall control.

Treatment should be made at frequent intervals, no longer than three weeks to one month apart and whenever moth or carpet beetle are seen.

When actual "mothproofing" is required to protect clothing stored for extended periods, use our Mothproofer.

Moth Control is intended for control of clothes moth and carpet beetle in clothing manufacturing plants, clothing stores, tailor shops, fur shops and similar locations.

Control of moth and carpet beetle is achieved by periodic spraying of the affected areas so that the fabric, clothing or garment itself is contacted by a light spray sufficient to kill exposed insects, but not heavy enough to wet the fabric, as well as by spraying certain physical parts of the building or storage area itself to reach breeding locations.

Additional instructions may be had by spraying the inside surfaces of storage drawers, bins, cabinets or shelves.
