CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist and vapors. Provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of skin contact, wash promptly with soap and water. In case of eye contact, flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

When used in commercial food processing, storage, preparation or serving areas, or in the house, all processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food. Do not apply while processing, preparation, or serving is underway. After space spraying, wash all equipment, benches, shelving, etc., where exposed food will be handled, with potable water.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat, fire, sparks, or flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause can to burst with violence and cause injury.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store upright in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Keep out of reach of children. If container is damaged and leaking, allow contents to dissipate out of doors.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Replace cap and wrap container and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

## LEFT-HAND PANEL

This water-based aerosol is designed for use in Households, Food and Non-Food Areas of Warehouses, Food Processing Plants, Motels, Theaters, Schools, and Offices. This formulation contains Pyrethrum along with a dual synergist system, making it very fast-acting with maximum efficacy on both flying and crawling insects. This product will kill and control Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Sandflies, Flying Moths, Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Crickets, Ants, Scorpions, Centipedes, Sowbugs, Spiders, Fleas, Clothes Moths, Carpet Beetles, and Bedbugs.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL: Shake well before use. Hold container upright when using. Apply in short bursts.

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS, HORNETS, SANDFLIES, FLYING MOTHS: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a low, sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for average room (1,000 cubic feet). Keep nozzle three feet from surfaces. Vacate premises. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry.

TO KILL ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, ANTS, SCORPIONS, CENTIPEDES, SOWBUGS, SPIDERS: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas and openings around sinks and pipes, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas, and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails, and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL CLOTHES MOTHS, CARPET BEETLES: Spray all articles to be protected, giving particular attention to folds and seams. Spray interior of storage containers such as closets, chests, and trunks regularly. Treatment should be repeated every thirty days unless the articles are stored in a moth-tight container.

TO KILL BEDBUGS: Spray mattresses thoroughly, especially around seams and tufts. Spray bedstead, baseboards, and floorboards. Repeat frequently.

TO KILL FLEAS: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pets quarters after spray has dried. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.
