2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 4077-96."
- b. Under the Precautionary Statement heading, replace the statement "Do not use in commercial food processing" with the following precautions. These precautions should be added under the Directions For Use:

Do not apply directly to food. Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods

may be prepared or held. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

Nonfood areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets, and storage (after canning or bottling).

- c. Use in food handling establishments can imply use in U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Meat and Poultry Plants. Therefore, either add the statement "Not for Use in USDA Meat and Poultry Plants," or submit an application to USDA requesting use in these areas. If granted, you can then indicate on the label that the product can be used in these areas.
- d. Move "Kennels" to the end of the list of sites in order to avoid "Non-food Areas of Kennels" as a site.

3. Please provide the flashpoint of the product with propellant for the Confidential Statement of Formula and the flashpoint/flame extension of the product for the data matrix. The flashpoint reported exceeds the one expected for the product. Please check and resubmit. Mixtures marketed under pressure, including those containing hydrocarbons, are subject in their entirety to tests indicated in Section 158.10(h)(2)(iii) of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations. (Flashpoints are conveniently measured after collecting the liquid expelled from the container in an open cup chilled with dry ice.)

4. submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner in which it is not labeled. GRANITE PQ-20 is used to treat algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds that do not contain fish. For maximum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth of algae should be treated to using GRANITE PQ-20.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of GRANITE PQ-20 per 10,000 gallons of water. For removal of settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a pool with algae growth require an initial dose of 4 to 7 fluid ounces of GRANITE PQ-20 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 7 to 10 fluid ounces of GRANITE PQ-20 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 7 to 10 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds with algae growth require an initial dose of 4 to 7 fluid ounces of GRANITE PQ-20 per 1000 gallons of water. For a cleaned spa, whirlpool, hot tub, decorative fountain, or pond add 4 fluid ounces of GRANITE PQ-20 per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 to 2 fluid ounces of GRANITE PQ-20 should be made every 7 to 10 days for maintenance.

GRANITE PQ 20 will prevent algae growth during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. For pools treated during the swimming season and are free of visible algae growth, add 32 fluid ounces of algaeicide per 10,000 gallons of water. If season pools have some visible algae growth, add 37 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of the product be made for maximum effectiveness. If necessary to repeat the treatment one or more times during the season.

GRANITE PQ 20 is compatible with other chlorine products used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both low and high pH. GRANITE PQ-20 can be used in pools containing chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals. However, do not mix GRANITE PQ-20 with other chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL
STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. Mop up spilled product. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and pets.

General: Use Residual Spray from _____ as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below. Apply this product only as a coarse spray or crack and crevice treatment to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT:

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders, Sowbugs and Carpet Beetles: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves refrigerators, and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do Not Spray Pets With This Product.

FOR CRACK AND CREVICE:

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas, and Carpet Beetles: Apply diluted spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

Flies and Mosquitoes: Use only out of doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surface will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
