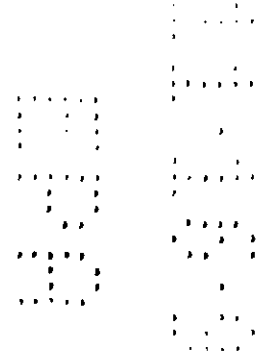

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.
- IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air if effects occur. Call a physician. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
- IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
- IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

This product is designed for use in Apartments, Attics, Basements, Boats, Box Cars, Cabins, Campers, Closed Barns, Day Camps, Garages, Homes, Horse Stables, Household Storage Areas, Kennels, Pet Sleeping Areas, Rooms, Greenhouses, Ship Cabins, Lath Houses, Seed Houses, Washrooms, and the Non-Food/Feed Areas of Schools, Theaters, Trucks, Warehouses, Box Cars, Hospitals, Hotels, Industrial Plants, Motels, and Preschools.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. Non-food areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets, and storage (after canning or bottling).

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT.

Step 1: PREPARATION: Put out all pilot lights and flames. Open cupboards, cabinets, trunks, and doors to area to be treated to allow maximum kill in all areas where insects can hide and breed. Close outside doors and windows and shut off fans and air conditioning to maximize killing power of fog. Remove pets, birds, and tightly cover or remove fish bowls and aquariums before spraying. Cover waxed wood floors and waxed furniture in the immediate area surrounding the fogger. (Newspaper may be used). Remove or cover exposed foods, dishes, utensils, or food handling equipment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. Shut off electrical appliances. Do not place activated fogger in a cabinet or under a counter or table. Do not use fogger in an areas less than 100 cubic feet.

Step 2: ACTIVATION OF FOGGER: SHAKE WELL JUST BEFORE USING. Place a section of newspaper on floor in center of room to be treated. NOTE: Do not place fogger on water-stainable surface. With can at arms length and valve opening pointing away from face and eyes, press actuator tab down, hooking the catch under the lip of the valve cup, and place can upright on the newspaper. LEAVE BUILDING AT ONCE AND KEEP BUILDING CLOSED FOR 2 HOURS (30 minutes for flying insects) BEFORE AIRING OUT. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

This container will release the total contents when activated and treats up to 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area (a room 30' x 25' with an 8' foot ceiling). For fleas and ticks, use one 6-ounce can for every 1,500 cubic feet of room space.

To kill Ticks and Fleas: Destroy pet's old bedding and replace, use product as above. Treat dogs and cats with registered tick & flea control product prior to re-entry.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing vapor and spray mist. May be harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and clothing. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish and other aquatic organisms. Do not contaminate water by disposal of waste.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

CAUTION: Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat, fire, sparks, or flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause can to burst with violence and cause injury. Do not use this unit in an area less than 100 cubic feet. **IMPORTANT!** To avoid **FLAMMABILITY HAZARD**, use only one can per room; do not place can in cabinet or under counter or table; shut off electrical equipment; put out all flames, including pilot lights, before spraying.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store upright in a cool, dry area away from heat, sparks, and open flames. Keep out of reach of children. If container is damaged and leaking, allow contents to dissipate out of doors.

Disposal: Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
