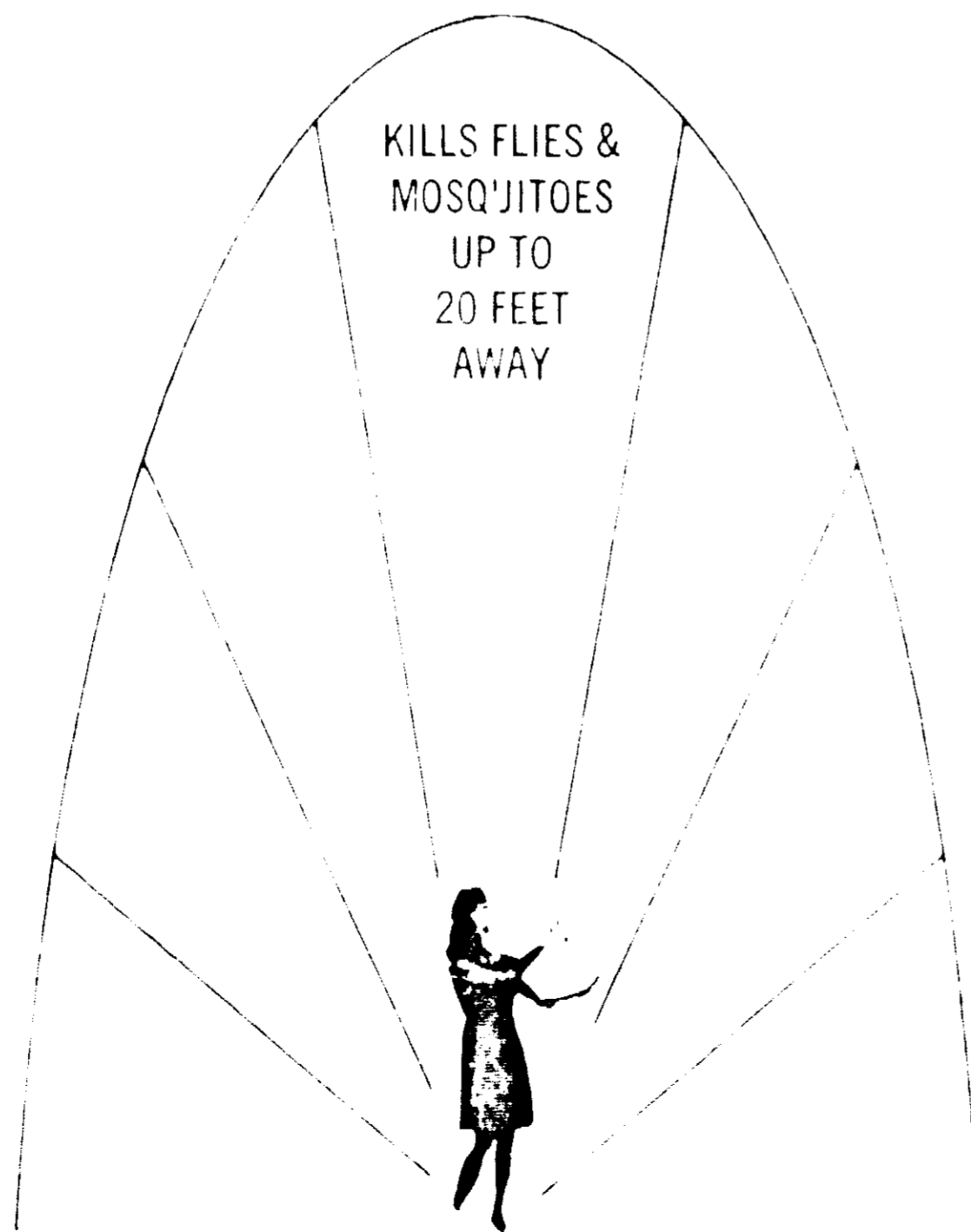

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SHAKE BEFORE USE

Point valve opening away from face and spray downward. For best results, use when wind direction is slight.

For Flying Insects: Spray with the nozzle directed toward drift over area to be protected when treating grass, bushes, stand at least 4 to 6 feet away and treat spray areas to be protected. Repeat as necessary.

For Crawling Insects: Apply Crickets, Centipedes, and infested surface of patio or porch, etc. Killing crawling insects as possible. Spray bed of ticks and fleas to repel crawling insects. Spray ant trails and trails thoroughly for best control.

CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Avoid inhalation. Do not spray toward face. Do not smoke while spraying. Do not expose food. Do not apply to food trays or on household pets. Avoid skin contact.

WARNING

FLAMMABLE - DO NOT USE NEAR FIRE OR FLAME

Not for indoor use. Keep 4 to 6 feet away from ornamental plants when spraying. Do not inhale the spray.
Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or burn. Do not use in confined spaces. Do not use in areas where temperature may exceed 120 degrees Fahrenheit. Do not use in areas where there is a fire hazard.
