HOG OILERS

Hog Oil with Lindane being low-freezing, remains quite thin in very cold weather, therefore it is excellent for use in Hog Oilers.

An effective hog oiler or rubbing post can be made by setting a post firmly in the ground and wrapping it securely with gunny sack or rope that is kept saturated with oil. Pour oil over the post covering from time to time, or a can of oil may be fastened to the top of the post and the rope or gunny sack kept saturated by fastening the upper end in the vessel of oil.

The use of T.V.B. Hog Oil with Lindane is limited to use in Hog Oilers only: one of the principal active ingredients being oil, T.V.B.
