Hand Sanitizing — In food handling and meat cutting operations: Rinse hands and immerse in a 1 oz. #175 LYNDE-PHOR per 5 gals. of water solution (25 ppm titratable iodine).

Retort Cooling Water — For canning operations — add 1 oz. #175 LYNDE-PHOR per 5-10 gallons of retort water prior to starting up operation to control slime and odor causing bacteria.

Poultry Drinking Water Sanitization — 1 oz. #175 LYNDE-PHOR per 10 gallons of drinking water.

Shoe Bath Sanitizer — To prevent tracking harmful organisms into animal areas, scrape shoes and place in a 3 oz. per gallon solution of #175 LYNDE-PHOR for 30 seconds prior to entering area.

Apply #175 LYNDE-PHOR to mop or mechanical floor cleaning until thorough. Surfaces should remain wet for 2 minutes. Prepared daily for use on dirty floors.

#175 LYNDE-PHOR "step" cleaner-removes the presence of organic soil and 400 ppm hardness.

Disinfection — Health Care Schools, Farms

Apply 1/2 oz. per gallon to walls, linoleum, porous surface tile, porcelain, soiled areas, etc.

For farms and poultry, other surfaces removed from troughs, race appliances, floors, walls traversed by poultry.

After disinfecting, other closed spaces, animals or employees should not be absorbed.

Sanitizing — Mop and utensils: scrape, or mop with #175 LYNDE-PHOR (cleaner). Rinse surfaces with water per 5 gallons. Surface should be wet 2 minutes. Drain and rinse is required.
