  - c. In the Directions for Use, under the statement "Only for formulation into products for the following uses", revise the following uses to read:
    - **Domestic indoor (household – Bait stations only)**
    - **Animal Health (Dogs and cats only)**
  
2. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/registration review of your product when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
  
3. Within sixteen (16) months of the date on this NOR, provide to the Agency acceptable data for Guideline Studies as follows:
 

*OPPTS 830.6317, (Storage Stability) and OPPTS 830.6320 (Corrosion Characteristics). If acceptable data is not submitted within 16 months of this NOR, this registration will expire on November 13, 2012.*
  
4. You will be held to the same conditions as the product you cited as a basis for the finding that your product is identical or substantially similar to the currently registered product, EPA Reg. No. 432-1478. When additional conditions or requirements are applied to the cited product to address issues of concerns, the Agency will notify you and you will have 30 days to submit an amendment to conform to those conditions or requirements.
