DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

A combination of localized application and space treatment is recommended for maximum insect control.

Flying Insects: To control *House Flies, Fruit Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats, Wasps and Hornets*. Close all doors and windows and shut off ventilating systems. Use a mechanical, thermal or compressed air sprayer adjusted to deliver a fine mist. Direct the spray toward the upper parts of the room and other enclosure and fill it with mist. Use 1 ounce of spray for each 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes after spraying. Vacate the area after treatment and ventilate it thoroughly before reoccupying.

Crawling Pests: To control *Cockroaches, Silverfish, Crickets, Earwigs and Clover Mites*. Apply with a machine adjusted to deliver a coarse droplet spray. Spray infested areas thoroughly and direct the liquid behind baseboards, moldings, cabinets, shelves, sinks, door frames, window frames, pipes and into drains, dark corners cracks, crevices, recesses and similar hiding places or contact the insects wherever possible. Repeat the treatment if reinfestation occurs

Against Ant infestations: Treat shelves, cabinets and other storage areas. Spray the ant runs or trails and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks, crevices and under carpets where insects may be found. Treat the underside and topside of infested carpets. Spray inside of trunks, closets and interior areas of shelving.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE AND PROCEDURES: Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, litter, earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: This container should be then offer for recycling or recycled. Do not dispose of in a sanitary land fill or by incineration. Follow State and local procedures.

CONTAINER REUSE: ONE GALLON container. Wrap container in newspaper and discard in trash.

CAUTION

Caution: Avoid breathing of vapors. Avoid contact with eyes. If in contact with water. Get medical attention if swallowed; contains petroleum distillate. Do not apply as a space spray while underway. Foods should be removed before treatments. Thoroughly wash faces before reuse. In Federal poultry plants, all surfaces in contact with poultry should be washed and rinsed in potable water.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICES

IF SWALLOWED: Do not induce vomiting. Get medical attention directed by a physician. Call physician or poison control center.
IF INHALED: Remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if needed.
IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash affected areas with soap and water.

This product is extremely toxic to aquatic organisms. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (ponds, ditches, potholes). Runoff and drift from treated areas are hazardous to aquatic organisms. Do not contaminate water when washing equipment.
