To spray, remove lid on front of spray cap. Look into hole on top of cap, and turn cap until white mark appears. After use, turn cap until white mark disappears.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Hold can 6 to 8 inches from skin or clothing and spray with slow sweeping motion. FOR MAXIMUM PROTECTION, spray evenly with hand to moisten all exposed skin.

TO APPLY TO FACE: Spray palm of hand and spread on face and neck. Avoid contact with eyes and lips.

WORK ON CLOTHING TOO: Spray shirts, stockings, and hats. For ticks and chiggers also spray pants cuffs, socks and around openings in outer clothing. Will not damage nylon, cotton and wool. Should not be used on acetate, rayon, spandex, Dynel or Verel fabrics. May damage furniture finishes, plastics, painted surfaces and watch crystals.

DISPOSE: Do not use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
