This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

- 1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/ reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
- 2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:
 - a. Add the phase "EPA Registration No. 4822-450".
- b. Revise the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section to read "Harmful if absorbed through skin and inhaled. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse. Do not use on edible crops.".

- c. Under the Statement of Practical Treatment, you may wish to delete the IF SWALLOWED and IF IN EYES statements since the toxicity categories are IV and these statements are not required. Make the following revisions "IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention. IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.".
- d. Revise the Environmental Hazards statement to read "This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to any body of water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wastewaters.".
- e. Delete the advertising claims "The Off you don't put on" and "Sprays out far beyond ordinary insect sprays". Vague or non-specific terms implying unstated benefits and false or misleading comparisons with other pesticides are unacceptable.
- 3. Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

SHAKE BEFORE USING



Direct spray toward area being treated. Point nozzle away from face, other people, and animals. Hold can on slight downward angle. For best results, spray when air is calm. Allow a few minutes for product to take effect. Spray articles in the area like foliage and legs of furniture in addition to spraying air and allowing to settle. Spray from center when not breezy. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing.

SPRAY FROM CENTER WHEN NOT BREEZY (graphic)
SPRAY WITH WIND IF BREEZE IS BLOWING (graphic)
SPRAY ON FURNITURE LEGS AND FOLIAGE* (graphic)

FLYING INSECTS: Flies, mosquitoes, gnats, **small** flying moths, wasps and hornets. Allow fog (spray) to drift over area. Direct fog (**spray**) toward bushes or grass from at least 4 to 6 feet away. Give special attention to **br**eeding areas such as garbage cans and compost piles. Repeat as necessary.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Ants, crickets, centipedes. Spray infested surface of deck, patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants and crawling insects. Spray ant hills for best control. *Keep 4 to 6 feet away from ornamental plants while spraying.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in an area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. [Per PR Notice 94-2 the following Disposal statement, or a variation which does not alter its intent, may be used:

Disposal: This container may be recycled in the few but growing number of communities where (steel) aerosol can recycling is available. Before offering for recycling, empty the can by using the product according to the label. (DO NOT PUNCTURE!) If recycling is not available, wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.]
