DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply to humans, pets, plants or contaminate feed, foodstuffs, dishes or utensils. Remove pets and birds and cover aquariums. Cover or remove exposed food, dishes, utensils and food handling equipment.

For Indoor Residential Use: Shake well before each use. Hold container upright. Do not spray up into air. Apply to surfaces only. Point spray opening toward surface to be sprayed and press button firmly. Hold about 12" from surface being sprayed. Spray until surfaces are wet. Avoid excessive wetting of asphalt, tile, rubber and plastic materials. More frequent application will be required to maintain control on plywood surfaces.

Roaches, Waterbugs: (Using (attached) applicator wand,) spray until wet in cracks around baseboards and other hiding places. When bugs are driven out, spray directly. Ants: Apply to ant trails, also around doors, windows and wherever ants enter house. Silverfish, Crickets, Earwigs, Spiders: (Multi-colored Asian Lady Beetles) (stinkbugs) (including) (brown marmorated stink bug): Spray areas infested by these pests.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage: Store away from heat or open flames, in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children.

Pesticide Disposal: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! If empty: This container may be recycled in the few but growing number of communities where (steel) aerosol can recycling is available.
