**STORAGE:** Keep container closed when not in use. Store at 59°-86°. Do not contaminate water, food or feed.

Flush with large amounts of water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation persists seek medical attention.

**IF SWALLOWED:**  
Drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

**IF IN EYES:**  
In case of contact, flush immediately with plenty of water. Get medical attention.
