## BACK PANEL

### BIO-CLOR CONCENTRATE

BIO-CLOR CONCENTRATE is a bactericide and algicide when used as directed.

#### DIRECTIONS

For initial chlorination of any pool water, add one ounce of BIO-CLOR CONCENTRATE per 1,000 gallons of water. Thereafter, adjust the quantity of daily additions to maintain 0.6-1.0 ppm available chlorine. A swimming pool test kit is necessary for determining the proper amount to add. For average pool conditions, this quantity will be about 1/4 ounce per 1,000 gallons per day. Higher temperatures or increased bather loads may require larger or more frequent dosages. Pool water should be maintained at a pH of 7.4-7.6 for best results.

To compute pool capacity:

For Square or Rectangular Pools - Gallons = LengthXWidthXDepthX7.5.  
For Circular or Elliptical Pools- Gallons = Diameter X Diameter X  
Depth X 5.9
