The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

a. In the Environmental Hazards Statement since this product is not applied to crops growing in the field delete the following:

For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes.

b. You may delete "Apply this product only as specified on this label" since this statement is not required.

c. In the ingredient statement align the decimal points so they are on the same margin.

d. On the Unit label move Inert Ingredients so it is on the same margin as Active Ingredient.

e. On the Unit Label, the Storage and Disposal section is not required. Refer to the Proposed Label Regulations published in the FEDERAL REGISTER on September 26, 1984 on page 37990 for the required contents of a unit package label. If you retain it, use the appropriate language from the Storage and Disposal Section of the outer label.

2. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
