BEANS: For control of Mexican Bean Beetle, Bean Leafhopper, Spider Mites, Thrips, and Aphids apply at the rate of 30 to 35 pounds per acre. Begin applications early and continue every 7 to 10 days. For best results apply to the undersides of leaves. Do not apply to beans within 3 day of harvest.

CABBAGE: For control of Aphids and Imported Cabbageworms, apply at the rate of 30 to 35 pounds per acre. Begin applications when Aphids or Worms first appear and continue every 7 to 10 days. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.
