
## #44 LATEX PAINT MILDEWCIDE

A fungleide to be added to latex paint to prevent mildew growth on the paint film.

Directions: Shake jar. Add two fl. oz. of #44 Latex Paint Mildewcide to one gallon of latex paint. Shake or stir thoroughly. Clean then disinfect surface before painting. For latex paint only. This chemical is not approved for use in paint that will be used in food processing areas.
