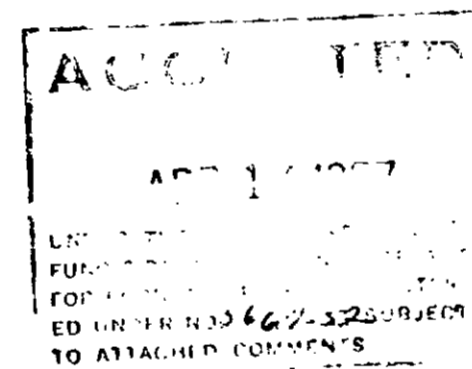

Malathion 0,0-dimethyl dithiophosphate of diethyl mercaptosuccinate	2.00 %
Beta-butoxy beta ¹ - thiocyno diethyl ether	2.00 %

DIRECTIONS

Apply so as to leave a wet coating, moving dispenser at the rate of about 2 feet per second.

Apply to baseboards, damp areas, cracks and crevices, hiding places and trails. Remove the cap. Hold can upright. Point valve opening away from face. Press button to release spray.

Roaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Crickets:
Spray infested cracks, shelves and storage areas and hiding places thoroughly. Direct spray into and around sinks, bath tubs, drains, laundry tubs, pipes through wall and floors. Spray behind cabinets, stove, refrigerator and counters. Will not stain woodwork.

Ants: Thoroughly spray ant trails and areas around door frames and window sills. If necessary treat the openings around water pipes, heat ducts, electrical outlets and baseboards where ants may come out into rooms from wall spaces and partitions.

Spiders and Scorpions: Spray wherever these insects may enter, such as around door frames and window sills.

Carpet Beetles: Direct spray to the infested area of floor baseboards and closet shelves, especially cracks and crevices. Spray the underside of carpets.

Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, June Bugs, Flying Moths:
As an aid to reduce the annoyance from these insects entering, spray the outside surfaces of screens, doors and window frames and other places such as open porch fixtures where these insects gather.

REPEAT TREATMENT AS NECESSARY FOR EFFECTIVE CONTROL.
SPRAY UNTIL WET.
