Use to prevent damage to ornamental ground cover and flowers by Pocket Gophers and damage around the house by Raccoons and Gray Squirrels.

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product with its labeling.

Apply directly on lawns except dichlor around approximately 1 ft away from other plant surfaces. Do not use within vegetable gardens.

As a dog repellent: To prevent defecation material and sprinkle repellent evenly at 1 lb per 100 sq ft. Reapply once a week after urinate in the area. Resume treatment.

As a cat repellent: To prevent digging on and under bushes. Fill hole and apply at 1 lb per 55 sq ft. Reapply once a week until problem reoccurs.

As a Gray Squirrel repellent: Apply at the base of trees, poles and fence posts in sand. Spread evenly. Repeat if longer a nuisance. Repeat treatment if problem reoccurs.

As a Pocket Gopher repellent (Geomys): At the rate of 1 lb per 100 sq ft around plants results repellent should be placed in the burrow. Seal burrow after treatment.

As a Rabbit repellent (Sylvilagus spp.): In trees and plants where browsing and chipping are forced. Spread evenly. Do not eat plant material. Retreat weekly.

As a Raccoon repellent: Apply at a rate around vegetable gardens, garbage cans, damage occurs. Since raccoons are nocturnal, when a nest is found, place a hole in the bed of upper debris as close application is not possible.

As a White and Black-tailed Deer repellent: spreading evenly at the rate of 1 lb per 100 sq ft around trees where browsing of lower branches. Cardboard cartons containing repellent sides may be hung from branches of the fences.

COVERAGE

Contents will treat from 110 to 350 square feet depending on persistence and type of unwanted animal.

Use to prevent defecation on lawns, flowers and vegetable gardens around hedges, shrubs, trees and to prevent digging lawns, flowers and vegetable gardens caused by cats and dogs. Use to prevent damage to ornamental ground cover and flowers by Pocket Gophers and damage around the house by Raccoons and Gray Squirrels.

Use to prevent browsing damage to ornamental trees and shrubs, ground covers and flowers by White and Black-tailed Deer and Rabbits.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply directly on lawns except di chondra & unusual ground covers. Apply approximately 1 ft. away from other plants, flowers, foliage and painted surfaces. Do not use within vegetable gardens.

As a dog repellent: To prevent defecation and urination remove old fecal material and sprinkle repellent evenly on effected area. Use at a rate of 1 lb per 100 sq. ft. Reapply once a week until dogs no longer defecate or urinate in the area. Resume treatment if problem reoccurs.

As a cat repellent: To prevent digging on flowers, vegetable gardens, lawns and under bushes. Fill hole and apply in the affected area at a rate of 1 lb per 55 sq. ft. Reapply once a week until digging stops. Resume treatment if problem reoccurs.

As a Gray Squirrel repellent: Apply at the rate of 1 lb per 55 sq. ft. around the base of trees, poles and fence posts and any areas where squirrels are a nuisance. Spread evenly. Repeat once a week until squirrels are no longer a nuisance. Repeat treatment if problem reoccurs.

As a Pocket Gopher repellent (Geomys and Thomomys spp.): Apply at the rate of 1 lb per 100 sq. ft. around plants where damage occurs. For best results repellent should be placed in the burrow at the rate of 1 lb per burrow. Seal burrow after treatment. Reapply if gopher repellent is washed off.

As a Rabbit repellent (Sylvilagus spp.): Apply at a rate of 1 lb per 55 sq. ft. around plants where browsing and damage occurs. If white rabbit droppings are noticed. Spread evenly around vegetable gardens, flower beds and other ornamentals. Retreat weekly until no more damage occurs.

As a Raccoon repellent: Apply at a rate of 1 lb per 55 sq. ft. Treat areas around vegetable gardens, garbage cans and other places where raccoon damage occurs. Since raccoons are nocturnal, apply repellent in early evening. When a nest is found, place a cardboard containing repellent with holes punched in upper side as close to the nest as possible. If this application is not possible.

As a White and Black-tailed Deer repellent: Treat ground cover by spreading evenly at the rate of 1 lb per 55 sq. ft. Scatter around ornamental trees where browsing of lower branches or damage to bark is noticed. Cardboard cartons containing repellent, with holes punched in upper sides may be hung from branches of trees & fastened to tree trunks and limbs.

COVERAGE

Contents will treat from 110 to 250 sq. ft. depending upon the persistence and type of unwanted animal pest.

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
