FOR REGULAR MAINTENANCE: Add 1/2 PINT of AQUA-40 for each 50,000 gallons of pool water every 3 to 5 days.

Initial dose is used when filling pool at beginning of swimming season. If pool has visible algae growth, treat with initial dose. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove algae debris. If visible algae are still present or re-appear, repeat this treatment procedure as necessary. When pool is free of visible algae, use the recommended maintenance dose.

Maintenance dose should be added at 3-5 day intervals. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently.

If make-up water is added at the rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity, add 8 ounces of AQUA-40 for each 10,000 gallons of fresh make-up water added per week.
